
The headlines are real.

In two-thirds of workplace homicides, the assailant has no known personal relationship with the victims, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. But not all incidents are physical. Often violence at work is psychological in nature. The most common types of workplace violence are bullying, intimidation and threats. They are also the least reported.
